Corporate Golf Days at Rössmund

Corporate Golf Days are a great way to raise funds for a "Cause" close to your heart – whether it be a school, sport club, welfare organization, trust or other great reason. At the same time, much fun can be had for those taking part, and the event organizer receives recognition in the media, community, and online thus driving marketing and advertising for themselves as well. A WIN-WIN for all!

How to get started?

- Find a suitable date for your event. Normally corporate days are held on a Friday so please bear that in mind.
- Plan on having at least 2 months' time to prepare for the event and gather enough teams to make it worthwhile.
- You will then need to find sponsors from various businesses for teams, prizes, hole sponsors etc.

The Format

- Through experience we have found that a "3 man scramble drive" with 2 teams playing together works best.
- Tee-off is simultaneous at the first and tenth tee which allows for a faster event.
- If more than 36 teams, a shotgun start is possible - this is a simultaneous tee-off from multiple tee-boxes with a horn blasted to get the balls rolling and completion at more or less the same time for all.
- A good start time is around 11am so that the last players come in around 17h00, assuming about 6 total hours of play. The prize-giving can be scheduled just after play ends, say around 17h30/18h00.

The Costs involved

- The entry fee per team should include a fixed green fee per player (based on our current member rates for 18 holes) as well as the cost of a halfway house and/or prize-giving lunch or dinner.



- Catering may only be offered by our kitchen and thus the costs must be taken into account when planning the budget.
- We have golf cars available at current member rates with a maximum of 6 cars available. These must be pre-booked to ensure availability.
- As an example based on a team consisting of 3 players: With a greens fee of N\$160 per player, plus a halfway house of N\$60 per player, the costs that need to be paid to Rössmund per team will be N\$660. Any amount charged over and above this cost per team will then be profit to the fundraiser.
- Potential sponsors not wanting to sponsor a team can always sponsor prizes of any nature instead. Alternatively they may opt to assist with the sponsoring of the catering. Or they can promote their own products at a specific hole at a rate established per hole.

Catering Ideas

- Usually a halfway house is included in the entry fee per team. This can vary from sandwiches to open brötkens to light lunches and will depend completely on what you have budgeted for.
- For the prize-giving, another meal such as platters or a braai or even formal sit-down dinner can be arranged.
- Please note that we do not encourage any outside food being brought onto our premises and that should any sponsors want to assist with catering, that they do so with providing the funds for paying of the catering. The sponsor can also contact our catering manager directly to discuss the options.

- You can also hang your poster up on the pin-boards at the golf course clubhouse.

Important Points to Note / Terms & Conditions

- It is important to book the date well in advance.
- Please inform the golf course of the number of teams & players as well as the anticipated tee-off times at least 3 days in advance so that the management can make preparations for the course and catering.
- All catering will be provided by the Rössmund Golf Course cc kitchen.
- If individual sponsors are to be advertised on specific holes, then liaise with Rössmund Golf Course Management regarding the following:
 - NO VEHICLES are allowed on tee-boxes and/or greens!
 - NO PEGS to be driven in grass on tee-boxes (pipes underground will be damaged).
 - STRICTLY NO DRIVING on fairways with vehicles by anyone.
 - ORGANIZERS MUST TAKE FULL RESPONSIBILITY for this, making sure the advertisers are aware of this.
- The bar will be stocked by the Golf Course. NO ALCOHOL OR BEVERAGES may be brought onto the premises without prior approval by Golf Course Management.
- All litter must be removed from sponsor stations when day is over.
- In case of ANY damage to Golf Course property, it must be reported to the Golf Course Management and the Organizer may be liable for repairs.
